SI. No. The school is directed to ensure that :

The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 18, of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. Any further increase of

	section shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	School has applied for fresh affiliation upto senior secondary level. However, NOC uploaded in the portal is upto 8th standard. It has been observed that NOC from class 1-12 (NOC082023997 dated 09.08.2023) is available in school website under mandatory public disclosures; hence, school is required to upload the same in SARAS portal under Compliance Section.
3	Certificate of sanitation and hygienic conditions uploaded by the school does not have the stamp of the issuing authority; hence school is required to submit the certificate of safe drinking water and sanitary condition, duly stamped by the issuing authority, as per prescribed format within 3 months on SARAS.
4	The lift to access the upper floors is not functional. The school is required to make provision with proper possible infrastructural facilities for CWSN students to access upper floors by a ramp or lift as prescribed by the RPwD Act 2016 and Circular No. 05 dated 06.03.2023 issued by the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
5	The labs available in the school have curtains, which are considered dangerous from the safety point of view. Further, inadequate seating arrangement for students is seen in the labs. School has to remove the curtains from all the labs, make proper seating arrangement and upgrade the labs in light of the SOPs issued by the board within 3 months and submit compliance in SARAS with videography.
6	Mathematics Lab does not have the seating arrangement for students and adequate storage arrangement for storing the labs material. The school shall upgrade the math lab as per SoP issued by the board within3 months and submit compliance on SARAs with videography.
7	Library appears to be under stocked and does not have enough stock of books for senior secondary level. Further, it does not have separate reading space for the staff. The school shall upgrade the library as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
8	Composite science lab has also not been maintained and upgraded as per SOPs/recommended infrastructure and facilities communicated vide Circular No. 11/2022. Exhaust fans, gas pipeline, bins for biodegradable waste/non-biodegradable waste, fire extinguishers, etc. have not been found in the lab. Lab is not properly equipped and also does not have seating arrangement for students. Lab is under stocked. The school shall upgrade the composite lab as per SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
9	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Panchkula within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
